Thank you to Galilee for your continued support for the food bank at North County Emergency Outreach Network.

Food has been distributed as it comes in, last year at this time, food valued at \$68,000 had been distributed. As of this year, \$75,000 has been distributed to date.



Especially needed is sugar, boxed spaghetti and pasta sauce, boxed stuffing, instant potatoes, canned chili, sloppy joe sauce, canned fruit, canned mixed vegetables, pork and beans, canned potatoes, canned ham, tuna, chicken and Spam, canned gravy, small jars of peanut butter, canned milk, and powdered milk.
